Facilities

Galileo's world-class Data Center, located in Englewood, Colorado, is engineered to eliminate all single points of failure and keep applications running around the clock.

Our operation uses a wide spectrum of hardware and operating system platforms. The overall operation comprises nearly two dozen mainframe servers and hundreds of Unix and NT machines. Our worldwide delivery is dependent on managing the close harmony between the Legacy systems and the open systems. This diversity increases our flexibility and strengthens our capability to deliver the right business and customer solutions.

The hardened Data Center has two computer buildings with a combined floor space of approximately 236,000 square feet - about the size of 84 tennis courts. An administration building and energy building are located on

the same site. The computer complex is powered by two separate underground power feeds with thirteen diesel generators on permanent stand-by to provide back-up power in an emergency.

High sensitivity smoke alarms are installed throughout the Data Center and there are two sophisticated automatic fire suppression systems. Site security is provided by a perimeter fence, security cameras, around-the-clock patrols and stringent access controls. And advanced hardware, software and firewall technology keep our operations virtually immune from online attacks. Your data will be safe with Galileo.
